# Older Americans Month- May 2023

## General Information

### Prerequisites

Before any nominee can be considered by the Awards Committee, the following prerequisites must be met:

- 1) The Nominator must respond to the questions developed by the Committee.
- 2) The Nomination must be received by the Awards Committee on or before the deadline of **April 14, 2023**. Nominations received after the deadline will not be considered.
- 3) The Nominee for Senior Citizen of the Year must be 60 years of age or older at the time the nomination form is submitted.
- 4) The nominee may be a person, persons or organizations, as applicable.
- 5) The nominee must be engaged in the provision of the services for at least one year at the time of submission of the nomination, as applicable.
- 6) Supporting documentation may be submitted. Please be advised that it will not be returned.
- 7) The Nominee for Senior Worker of the Year must be employed and have worked at the business for at least 3 months in 2022. *Workers through training and subsidized employment programs are not eligible...*

### Criteria for Judging

In examining all nominations, the Awards Committee will allocate points based on the following criteria:

**A. Impact of the Accomplishment** (30 points maximum) This criterion assesses the scope and impact of the accomplishments of the nominee. For example, higher ranking would be given to accomplishments that benefit the largest number of senior citizens, especially those socially needy.

**B. Creativity and Endurance of Activities** (30 points maximum) This criterion assesses the extent to which the activities used fresh, imaginative approaches and the extent to which those activities laid a foundation. For example, activities to build coalitions, new senior advocacy organizations, or new processes for impacting policy-decision makers would rank higher than an appearance before a Board of Supervisors or City Council on a single issue.

**C. Recognition** (10 points maximum) This criterion assesses the extent to which the nominee has been recognized publicly for his/her accomplishments and advocacy activities.

**D. Use of Community Resources** (20 points maximum) This criterion assesses the extent to which the nominee utilizes available community resources and/or develops community resources to achieve task(s).

**E. Application Elsewhere** (10 points maximum) This criterion assesses the extent to which others could use or replicate the success or could learn from the nominee's success.
